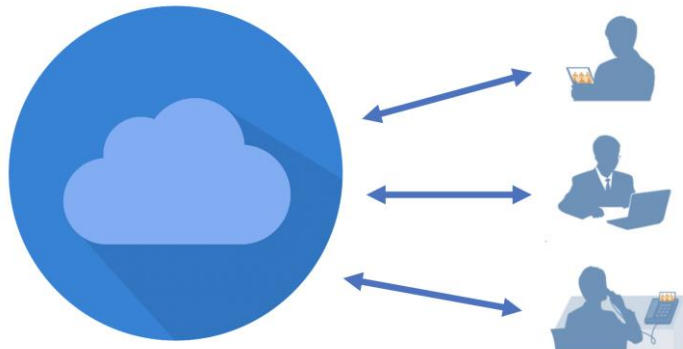

Be sure to follow all World Health Organization guidelines, whether you're a volunteer, paid worker, or aid recipient.

7. The Clubhouse provides an effective reach out system to members who are not attending, becoming isolated in the community or hospitalized.

During the daily Clubhouse unit meetings, staff and members are assigned members who have not been to Clubhouse in recent weeks. These members are

contacted via phone, email, or text to determine their mental and physical health and to ensure that they are not endangered of becoming socially isolated or hospitalized. During the Covid-19 pandemic and the District of Columbia stay at home order, the Clubhouse has not been able to meet in person. Clubhouse staff and members have been meeting daily virtually via Zoom. Reach out efforts continue on a daily basis to ensure the physical and mental well-being of all its members especially during these trying times.
